

Lake Granbury Master Gardener Scholarship Application

This application is designed for clarity and brevity. Please read each section carefully and completely. If you have any questions please call Hood County Texas AgriLife Extension at 817-579-3280.

Administration: General administration of this scholarship program is under the direction of the Lake Granbury Master Gardener Scholarship Committee. The committee members screen all applications and select the recipients. Applicants may be requested to interview with the committee. Scholarship recipients will be notified upon selection.

Allocation: A maximum of \$2000 is allocated for each one- (1) year scholarship and will be awarded with \$1000 per semester beginning with the fall semester. No more than two (2) scholarships will be awarded each year. Money will be paid directly to the college or university, not the student.

Qualifications:

1) The applicant must be a high school senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher or an undergraduate full-time (enrolled for 12 hours) college student with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Applicants must be Texas residents and intend to major in horticulture, agriculture or a related field. Preference shall be given to students from Hood County.

Instructions:

- 1) High school applicants must submit a high school transcript with this form. College applicants must submit a college transcript and may include a high school transcript if desired. Contact your school early to insure receiving the transcript to mail with this application.
- 2) The applicant must be recommended in writing by two people, excluding relatives, who have known the applicant for at least one year such as:
 - a. Teacher
 - b. Counselor
 - c. club advisor
 - d. church leader
 - e. employer
- 3) Deadline—completed applications must be received in the Lake Granbury Master Gardener office by March 15, 2010.

Re-qualification: A copy of pre-enrollment for a minimum of 12 semester hours and a copy of grades showing a GPA of 2.5 or higher for at least 12 semester hours during the previous semester must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by Dec.27, 2010.

Note: If the scholarship award is not used by the ending date of the award (after two consecutive regular semesters from the initial award), the unused portion of the award will be returned to the scholarship fund.
